Entry Summary (ENS) Declarations (Great Britain to Northern Ireland): Checklist for hauliers and carriers of standard goods [1/2]

	Ensure you and your customer <u>register</u> for the Trader Support Service (TSS).*
	Register for the <u>Goods Vehicle Movement Service</u> (GVMS)* in order to get a Goods Movement Reference (GMR).
	Agree who will gather and submit the data required to complete Entry Summary Declarations (see following page).
	Note: If the Importer is authorised for the UK Internal Market Scheme (UKIMS) ensure the EORI number aligned with this is used as the Importer EORI.
	Ensure the data is submitted through the TSS Portal at least two hours before goods are due to arrive in Northern Ireland.
	Create a GMR in TSS (by using GMR Automation functionality) or in GVMS. See the Creating a Goods Movement Reference guide for more information.
	Once the GMR is completed, you can board the ferry and move the goods.
	Ensure drivers check the driver inspection portal on <u>GOV.UK</u> if the shipment needs an inspection.

What is an Entry Summary Declaration?

- An Entry Summary Declaration is a required form that indicates safe and security data associated to all goods moved from Great Britain to Northern Ireland.
- It is the legal responsibility of the carrier to ensure safety and security information is declared via the Entry Summary Declaration. However, other parties (trader, haulier or intermediary) may agree to complete it.

Note: Carrier is defined as the operator of the active means of transport

How does TSS support Entry Summary Declarations?

- TSS provides a portal for registered traders, carriers and hauliers to provide safety and security data that TSS will use to generate and submit Entry Summary Declarations / Simplified Frontier Declarations to the Import Control Service (ICS) and HMRC.
- TSS uses the data and creates Supplementary Declarations for traders/importers to complete.
